

# South Metro Denver Realtor Association and RE/MAX Professionals present checks totaling \$42,500 to Habitat for Humanity

The South Metro Denver Realtor Association (SMDRA) and RE/MAX Professionals each presented a check for \$21,250 to Habitat for Humanity during SMDRA's weekly marketing meeting at the association's headquarters in Littleton on Friday, June 12, 2015. The total contribution of \$42,500 represents half of the full home sponsorship needed for a Habitat home for a deserving family scheduled for initial construction this August at 2323 W. Harvard Avenue in Englewood.

In addition to the financial support, SMDRA Realtor and affiliate members along with agents with RE/MAX Professionals, will participate in the home's construction by volunteering hundreds of hours of hard work, including roofing, painting, landscaping, and more.

The checks were presented to Jeanne Fischetti, Director of Corporate Partnerships for Habitat for Humanity in Colorado, by Victoria Gartelos of Metro Brokers – The Castlewood Company, a SMDRA Director and head



of SMDRA's Philanthropies Committee, and Brad Whitehouse, Managing Broker at RE/MAX Professionals.
