BE COMMITTED TO THE ELECTRICAL STATES OF THE E

- ✓ adhere to all local Social Distancing Guidelines, maintaining 6 foot distance between all people.
- ✓ wear a mask and gloves, require & provide them to clients that don't have them, for any customer interactions or work being done in third-party homes.
- ✓ minimize all in-person meetings and conduct meetings remotely, if possible.
- ✓ provide documents electronically as much as possible.
- ✓ maintain detailed logs of the interactions to enable contact tracing if
 it becomes necessary.
- ✓ ask all buyers and sellers if they are sick or have been sick before showings.
- ✓ allow only one showing at a time without overlapping appointments
- ✓ **not allow open houses,** and no in-person meetings, showings, appraisals, consultations or gatherings of more than 3 people at one time inside a property.
- ✓ encourage clients and customers to conduct virtual showings, including photos, live-streaming or on-line virtual tours before scheduling in-person private showings.
- ✓ seek to pre-qualify buyers and tenants when possible to limit number of in-person showings.
- ✓ travel to showings whenever possible by separate vehicles or meet at property.
- ✓ provide guidance and encourage personal sanitation, frequent hand-washing, the use of hand sanitizers, disinfectant wipes, sprays, etc.
- ✓ not allow food or beverage offerings during on-site showings.
- ✓ sanitize high-touch surfaces and make sure disinfecting happens between showings
