Affiliate Quarterly Success Sessions

The revamped SMDRA Affiliate Committee is now focused on helping all Affiliates build stronger relationships with REALTORS®, grow their businesses, and stay connected through four quarterly Affiliate/Industry Partner Success Sessions, each featuring practical education, industry panels, and a built-in social hour. Affiliates will also receive enhanced support through twice-annual New Affiliate Orientations and the ongoing Affiliate Task Force, which welcomes new members, provides mentorship connections, and promotes involvement in SMDRA programs and sponsorship opportunities. This updated structure creates more meaningful engagement, better networking, and clearer pathways for Affiliates to get involved and succeed within the SMDRA community.

Diamond Circle Awards

This is largely a fund-raising committee which works to acquire sponsorships for SMDRA's Annual Top Producer Awards that celebrates the most successful members of the South Metro Denver REALTOR® community. Committee meets every other month or as needed. Meetings may become more frequent as event date approaches.

Description & Responsibility
